

Group Vision: To grow in Godly manhood together. Sharpening each other as iron sharpens iron (Prov 27:17) through the relational concept of Paul, Timothy, & Barnabas.

- Paul: Godly mentor that disciplined Timothy. The one that pours into the less experienced and wise.
- Timothy: Hungry mentee that sought discipleship. The one who seeks a wiser man to pour into him.
- Barnabas: Relatable friend and encourager to Paul in ministry. The Godly close friend that you can rely on.

Recap of the 4 Faces of Manhood (last 2 lessons): your manhood can't be just one dimensional; it needs to be able to express itself appropriately given different situations.

- **King Face:** Leading with integrity. Providing direction for others and loving what is right. This quality in a man is one that does not come as natural. Strong convictions, courageous moral choices, servant spirit, righteous leadership. Creates harmony through leading in love.
- **Warrior Face:** Courageous leadership through protecting, providing, persevering, and taking initiative for purpose greater than himself. A man of action and those actions flow out of submission to God.
- **Lover Face:** Relational aspect of a man that is strong in how he loves (sacrificially) those intimately – wife, children, parents, siblings, etc. Leading others in Godly love which prompts an internal desire to change for the better (towards God) and follow.
- **Friend Face:** Relational capacity of a man to connect with other men. The Barnabas role. Loyal, accountable, encouraging challenging, and fun! Men need buddies. When we are islands, things get dark.

Seasons (Part 1 of 2): Four Tools to Help Navigate the Seasons in a Man's Life

- **Reverse Engineering:**
 - Beginning with the end in mind
 - **Proverbs 21:5 “tells us that “the plans of the diligent lead surely to abundance, but everyone who is hasty comes only to want.”**
 - Where we want to go?
 - Where we want to end up?
 - What steps to take to get there?
 - Looking at someone's life that has gone before us to help navigate our own
 - **Philippians 3:17 “Join together in following my example (Paul), brothers and sisters, and just as you have us as a model, keep your eyes on those who live as we do.”**
 - **2 Timothy 3:14 “But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it.”**
- **Mentorship**
 - These are the Pauls in our life. The ones that pour into you.
 - **Proverbs 13:20 – “Whoever walks with the wise becomes wise, but the companion of fools will suffer harm.”**
 - Why is having a good mentor in your life so important?
 - Encouragement
 - Role Model
 - Accountability
 - Advice
 - Spiritual Growth
 - **1 Thessalonians 5:11 says, “Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.”**
- **Transition**
 - Understand that there will be different seasons in a man's life and transitions are usually rocky and can tests a man's faith since the path isn't well defined or clear
 - These transitions can be predictable but it doesn't make them any less challenging or testing
 - Understand that hope is not seen. We walk by faith because we put our hope in God!
 - **Romans 8:24-25 “For in hope we were saved. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what they already have? 25 But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently.”**
 - By walking in faith rooted in hope we can be consistent in the times that are rocky or it is hard to see where we are headed
 - **Romans 8:31 “If God is for me, then who could be against me?”**

- **Romans 8:28** “And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who[a] have been called according to his purpose.”
 - How does it feel knowing we can put trust in God through hope that is unseen that He will always take care of us and work things out for our good and the good of His kingdom at the same time?

➤ Laws of the Harvest

- 1) We reap what we sow
 - **Galatians 6:7-8** “Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that he will also reap. For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but to the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.”
 - **2 Corinthians 9:6** “The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.”
- 2) We reap more than we sow
 - **Proverbs 11:24** “One person gives freely, yet gains even more; another withholds unduly, but comes to poverty.”
 - **Proverbs 11:25** “A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed.”
- 3) We reap in a different season than we sow
 - **2 Corinthians 5:9-10** “So we make it our goal to please Him, whether we are at home in the body or away from it. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each of us may receive what is due us for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad.”
 - **Matthew 6:19-21** “Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal, but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”
 - **Galatians 6:9** “And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.”
