Jesus Saves Us & Jesus Changes Us

- What does it mean to become saved?
 - 100% Jesus – nothing of our own merit or works
 - By grace alone through faith alone
 - **Ephesians 2:8-9** For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast.
 - Becoming saved is understanding that you can't make yourself right with God and you need to receive the love and sacrifice offered through Jesus to make you right with Him. Through this He sees you perfectly as He sees Jesus.
 - "For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ." **2 Corinthians 5:21**
 - "The wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." – **Romans 6:23**
 - "But He (Jesus), having offered one sacrifice (Himself) for sins for all time, sat down at the right hand of God..." **Hebrews 12:10**
 - "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever BELIEVES in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life." **John 3:16**
 - From that time on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near." – **Matthew 4:17**
 - What does repent mean and how is this tied to forgiveness?
 - Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord. **Act 3:19**
- Opportunity to share testimony – I encourage you to share how you came to know the Lord!
 - So do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord or of me his prisoner. Rather, join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the power of God. **2 Timothy 1:8**
 - And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. **1 John 5:11**
 - Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony, "He told me everything I ever did." **John 4:39**
